B.S.F.A. County Cup Code of Conduct:

1. Fixture details should be confirmed by the respective teachers in charge at least one week in advance of the match date. Decisions should be reached, at this time, on team colours in case of a colour clash, and kick off time. It is also important that schools provide an accurate, and clearly stated, contact number in case of weather problems, postponements or travel difficulties.
2. County Cup fixtures will take priority over all other football fixtures except ESFA competition fixtures.
3. Failure to meet deadline dates without prior consultation with the Competition Secretary could result in the school being withdrawn from the competition entered.
4. Teachers must always promote the positive aspects of the sport (e.g. fair play) and never condone violations of the Laws of the Game, behaviour contrary to the spirit of the Laws of the Game or relevant rules and regulations as laid down by the E.S.F.A.
5. Teachers must consistently display high standards of behaviour and appearance.
6. Teachers, spectators and players should not use inappropriate language.
7. Teachers and their schools are responsible for the actions of their players and spectators. It is the responsibility of the teacher in charge of the team to maintain discipline of their players, before, during and after the match.
8. The teacher and school must encourage and guide players to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance.
9. Failure to adhere to this code of conduct in any respect could lead to exclusion from BSFA competitions.
